CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All exhibits in this section must be the bona-fide work of the exhibitor and must NOT be more than 3 years old or have won a prize in a previous Exhibition of the Tenterfield Show Society.
2. No portion of a collection may compete as a single exhibit.
3. Exhibits can be delivered to the JH Reid Pavilion to the show secretary's office before **noon on Friday, 29 January, 2021** (Items will also be accepted at the secretary's office at any time beforehand).
4. No exhibits are to be removed from the JH Reid Pavilion before Sunday morning. Exhibits cannot be removed without the permission of the Steward on Sunday and only between 8.30am and noon.
5. Any other article of Handcraft for which provision has not been made, will be classified on the day at the Judge's discretion if more than three articles the same.
6. Prizemoney can be collected from the secretary's office from 12 noon on Friday, 5 February until 5pm on Saturday, 6 February or at the show office until Thursday, February 26.
7. Exhibits can be collected from the show secretary's office from Monday, February 8. The pavilion will not be open for collection of exhibits on Sunday, February 7.
