## Terms and Conditions of Entry

1. A Horse Handling Participant Risk Acknowledgement and Waiver Form must be completed, and entry fees paid before you ride.
  2. It is a condition of entry at this show for all horses at the show, to compete on the understanding that drug testing may be carried out at this show, and if drugs are detected then penalties will apply. Treatment forms will not be accepted. Agricultural Societies Council rules apply.
  3. All competitors compete at their own risk.
  4. Competitors acknowledge that activities involving horse and cattle are dangerous, and that accidents causing death, bodily injury, disability and property damage can and do happen.
  5. There will not be any free gate entry or any gate refund to competitors.
  6. Horse stalls and stallion boxes are available on application. Payment must be made with the application.
  7. Maiden – is a Pony, Galloway or Hack that has not won a first prize at any agricultural or breed specific show. Novice – has not won an open championship at any agricultural or breed specific show.
  8. All ponies shall be under 14hh unless specified by breed.
  9. The Tenterfield show society reserves the right to make any changes to this schedule without notice.
  10. Judges must make 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> awards in classes where stated.
  11. Helmets must be worn by all competitors aged 18 years old or; and by all show jumping competitors
  12. Show jumping is conducted under EFA Rules 21<sup>st</sup> Edition.
  13. Prizes may comprise a combination of cash, product or local business vouchers

If the owner or lessee of the horse is an unfinancial member, a non-member, a Participant Member, a Subscriber Member, a Temporary Member or a Cancelled Member of the Society, the horse's registration is SUSPENDED and is ineligible for competition.
