4. Any embellishments natural as above and/or artificial [anything made or treated by man eg figurines, ribbon, polished stones]

F96. BARKED OVER. A design to feature bark to create a wall hanging. The design must have the main feature as bark but can include some succulents and moss to give texture and colour. Overall size to be no more than 30cmx40cm. Wall hanging to be prepared for hanging i.e. must have a wire suitable to place on hook that will be provided.

F97. LEAF'S MAGIC. An arrangement of leaves can include coloured or variegated leaves.

F98 Design in unusual container.

- F99. CENTRE OF ATTENTION. One flower amongst leaves or natural embellishments.
F100. RECYCLED A Dried Arrangement together with a recycled item.
F101. BLACK with one other colour Minimal green foliage
F102. ORIENTAL INFLUENCE
F103. DINNER TABLE ARRANGEMENT. Candles can be used.
